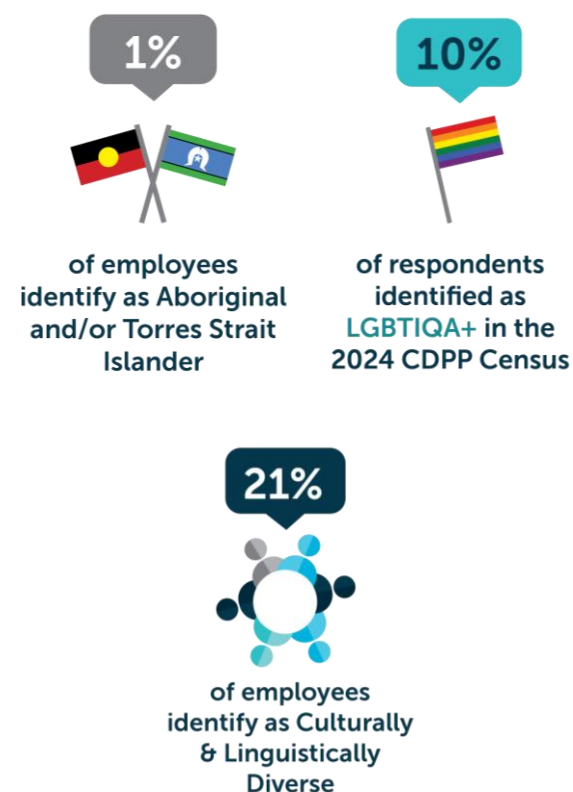

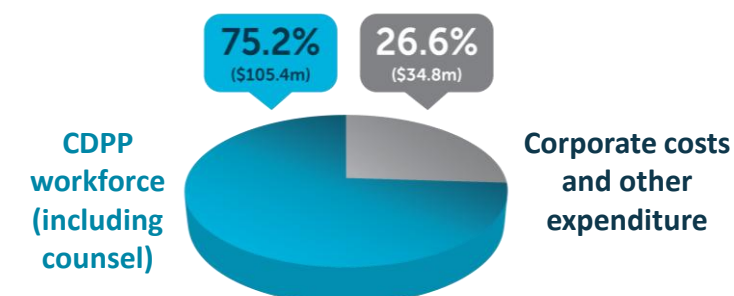
Total headcount by location

2025-26 Budget (\$138 million)



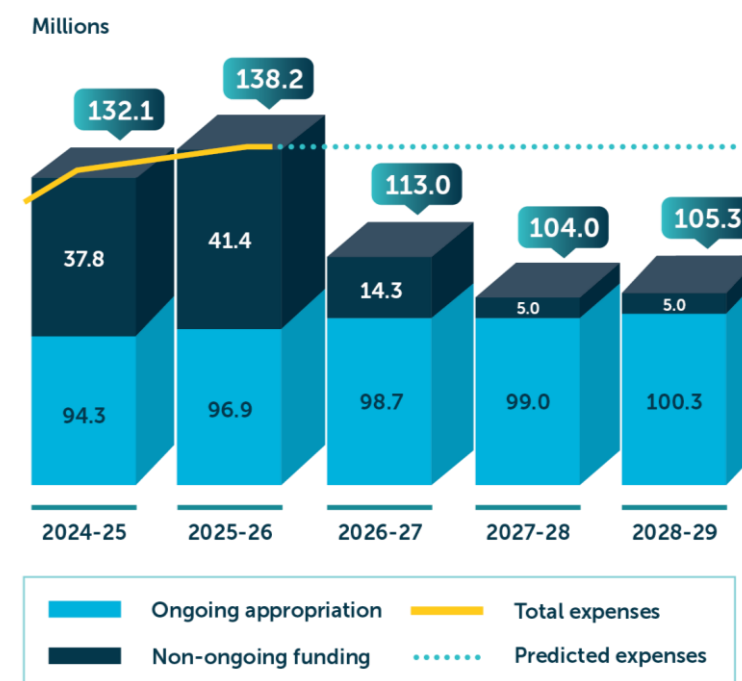
Legal and enabling headcount



Attendance type



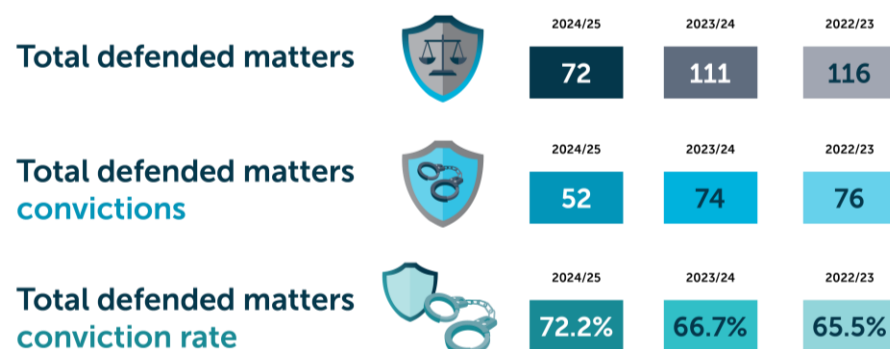
Ongoing vs non-ongoing funding



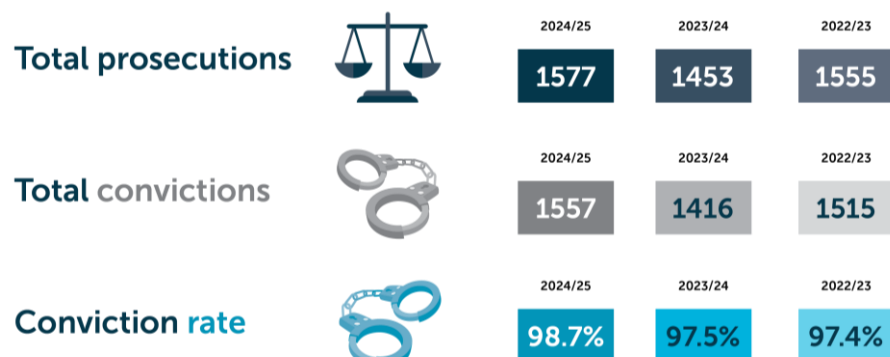
Matters received and completed



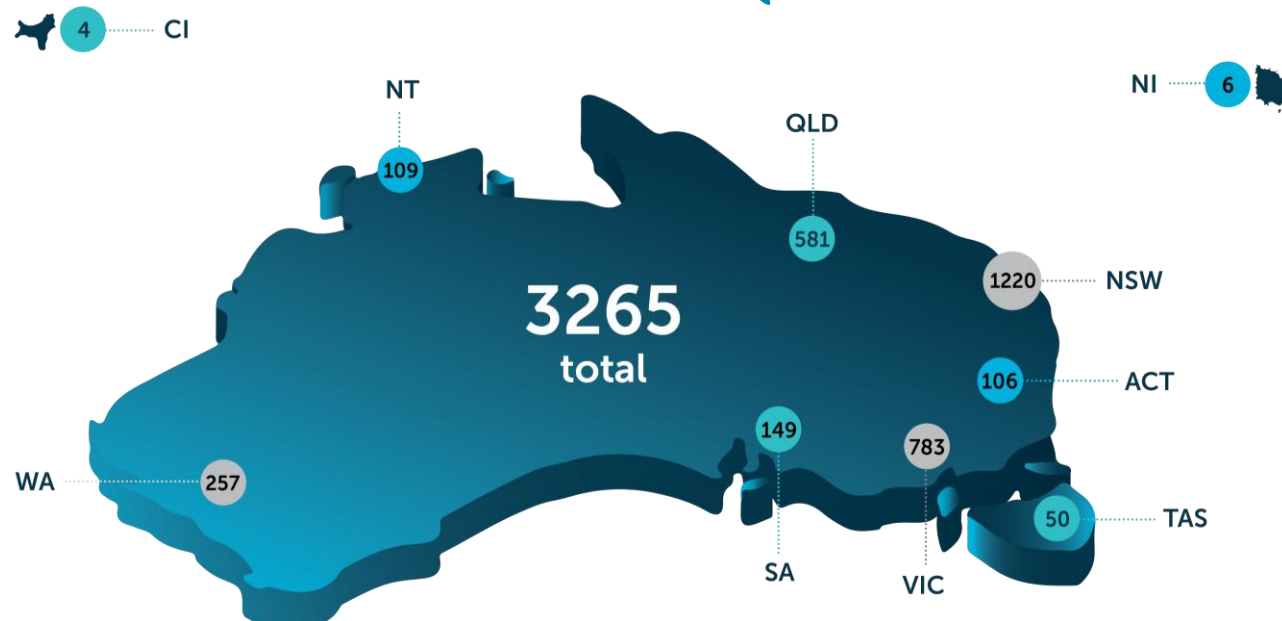
Defended matters convictions (target 70%)
