



Appointment of Director of Public Prosecutions

Director of Public Prosecutions Act 1983

I, QUENTIN BRYCE, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council and under subsections 18 (1) and (5) of the *Director of Public Prosecutions Act 1983*:

- (a) appoint Robert James Bromwich as Director of Public Prosecutions for a period of 5 years commencing on 17 December 2012; and
- (b) determine that, for matters not provided for by that Act, the office is held on the same terms and conditions that apply to the office of Secretary of the Attorney-General's Department under a fixed-term appointment to the extent that those terms and conditions are consistent with a determination under the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973* for the office.
