1 Name

This determination is the *Public Service (Subsection 24(1)- Office of the Commonwealth Director of Public Prosecutions Non-SES Employees) Determination 2024/04*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2024.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsection 24(1) of the *Public Service Act 1999*.

4 Definitions

In this instrument:

allowances means the allowances provided by section 6 of this determination.

CDPP means the Commonwealth Director of Public Prosecutions.

employee means an employee in the CDPP engaged under the PS Act.

Enterprise Agreement means the Office of the Commonwealth Director of Public Prosecutions (CDPP) Enterprise Agreement 2024-2027.

Federal Prosecutor means an employee engaged as a ‘Federal Prosecutor’ as referred to in Table A1 of Appendix A to the Enterprise Agreement.

Senior Federal Prosecutor means an employee engaged as a ‘Senior Federal Prosecutor’ as referred to in Table A1 of Appendix A to the Enterprise Agreement.

Principal Federal Prosecutor means an employee engaged as a ‘Principal Federal Prosecutor’ as referred to in Table A1 of Appendix A to the Enterprise Agreement.

PS Act means the *Public Service Act 1999*.

5 When this instrument ceases to apply

This instrument will cease to apply immediately after the last full pay period in June 2026.

Note: This instrument may also be revoked or have its operation affected by a further determination made under subsection 24(1) of the PS Act.

6 Allowances

- (1) Employees are entitled to the allowances specified in the following table from the first full pay period on or after 1 July 2024.

Table 1—Allowances

Column 1 CDPP Legal Classification	Column 2 Total allowance (per year) on commencement	Column 3 Total allowance (per year) from 13 March 2025	Column 4 Total allowance (per year) from 12 March 2026
Federal Prosecutor	\$15,000	\$15,570	\$16,099
Senior Federal Prosecutor	\$25,000	\$25,950	\$26,832
Principal Federal Prosecutor	\$35,000	\$36,330	\$37,565

- (2) The allowances will be paid fortnightly, consistently with the formula specified by clause 22 of the Enterprise Agreement.

7 Leave

- (1) Allowances will continue to be paid whilst an employee is on paid leave.
- (2) Allowances will not be paid whilst an employee is on unpaid leave.

8 Part time arrangements

If an employee is engaged on a part time basis, they will receive a pro rata allowance.

9 Higher duties

An employee performing higher duties will be paid the allowance applicable to the higher duties they are performing during any period that they are entitled to be paid higher duties allowance under the Enterprise Agreement.

10 Superannuation

The CDPP will make superannuation contributions on the payment of the allowances consistent with the Enterprise Agreement.
