CDPP Officers Serving on Juries

Officers working for the DPP 'whose duties involve the provision of legal professional services' are exempt from jury service pursuant to Regulation 5 of the *Jury Exemption Regulations 1987* (Cth).

Officers whose duties involve the provision of legal professional services and who are summonsed to attend Court for the purpose of serving on a jury, should advise the Court that they are exempt from jury service.

The position for officers whose duties do not involve the provision of legal professional services varies between States and Territories. Officers whose duties do not involve the provision of legal professional services and who are summonsed to attend Court for the purpose of serving on a jury, may inform the Court that they are employed by the office of the Commonwealth Director of Public Prosecutions.
