Strategic Commissioning Framework

As required by the *APS Strategic Commissioning Framework*, the CDPP has identified the legal (prosecution) job family as core work because this is the majority of our workforce. In 2026–27, the CDPP will take steps to further embed the APS Strategic Commissioning Framework and strengthen capability. The CDPP will continue developing internal expertise to reduce reliance on outsourcing and strengthen capability.

In order to fulfil its purpose, the CDPP will always have a need to engage barristers to provide the specialised legal services necessary to undertake complex, niche and technical legal work, including appearances in jury trials and appeals, including in superior courts and the High Court.
